## **Burt-Watts snags Dell Children's expansion contract**

Dell Children's Medical Center of Central Texas has tapped **Burt-Watts Industries Inc.** for a \$10.8 million expansion project.

Burt-Watts will be building a new 6,000-square-foot intra-operative MRI suite for the medical center. The operating room will include a state-of-the-art movable MRI machine, which will allow surgeons to safely image patients during brain surgery.

"The convergence of surgery and imaging are resulting in innovative spaces," said Shane Watts, founder and vice-president, Burt-Watts Industries. "This project has been a collaborative, orchestrated effort between our company and Seton to ensure the environment meets key objectives and the operations of the hospital are not disrupted during the construction process."

The new MRI suite, which is following Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Platinum standards, is slated to open summer 2009.
