Burt-Watts Industries Completes Two New Pediatric Health Clinics

Dell Children's Medical Center and Lone Star Circle of Care Launch Regional Pediatric Network for Underserved Children in Williamson County

AUSTIN, TX –October 28, 2010— Burt-Watts Industries, Inc., a leading Austin-based commercial general contracting firm, has completed two new state-of-the art pediatric clinics for Lone Star Circle of Care (LSCC), a federally qualified community health center, in Cedar Park and Hutto, Texas. Named Dell Children's – Circle of Care Pediatrics, the clinics are funded by a \$3 million grant from the Seton Family of Hospitals to sponsor a regional pediatric primary care network.

"There is a community need for increased access to pediatric healthcare services in Williamson County. And, it's estimated that more than 18,000 children in Williamson County are uninsured," said Pete Perialas, CEO of Lone Star Circle of Care. "We are excited to bring these new state-of-the-art clinics to this area, and these new facilities will offer a nurturing environment for all our young patients, from high-risk newborns to children and teenagers."

The two new clinics, which are located at 1730 East Whitestone Blvd. in Cedar Park, and 123 Ed Schmidt Blvd. in Hutto, have a total of 31 exam rooms and will provide services for about 10,000 patients with an estimated 30,000 visits projected per year.

"This project has been a collaborative, orchestrated effort between our company, Lone Star Circle of Care and Seton to ensure this one-of-a-kind project meets key objectives and provides us with state-of-the-art facilities," said Troy Chapman, Burt-Watts. "While the needs are urgent for these clinics, it was critical that the right expertise be brought to the table when dealing in often high-risk, high-traffic and sensitive environments."
